

## Labuan's people-centric projects in pipeline

LABUAN: The Labuan landscape is expected to evolve and change significantly with the implementation and completion of several development projects, says Datuk Rozman Isli.

Among projects in the pipeline are the RM174 million coastal road project to ease traffic congestion and improve the island's connectivity, replacement of old water pipelines islandwide and double

carriage-way project from Kampung Lajau to Kampung Lubok Temiang.

Rozman, who was Labuan MP in the 13th Parliament, said the government also approved the construction of artificial turf football field for sports development and upgrading of the Labuan Nucleus Hospital with additional facilities, health clinic, staff quarters and specialists.

"Some of these people-centric projects are in progress while the rest will be implemented this year," he said during the Program Santai Abang Man at Ramsay here Tuesday.

Rozman, who is also Labuan Corporation chairman, said the island had received a huge allocation from the Federal Government since it was elevated to federal territory status. —Bernama
